

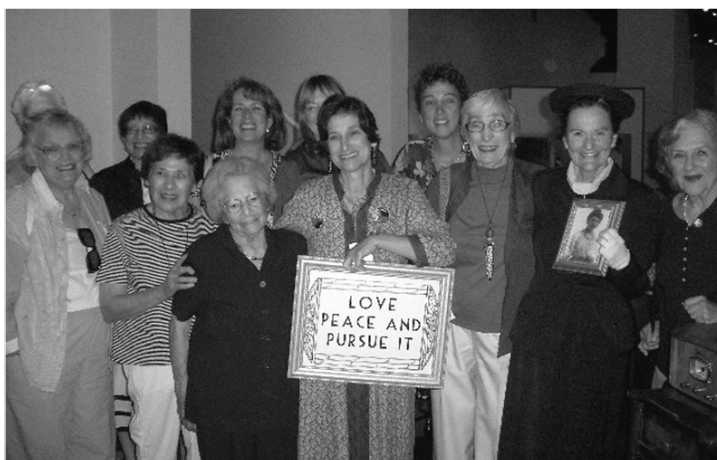

**NCJW MEMBERS ATTEND PORTRAYAL OF FORMER PRESIDENT**  
— On Aug. 6, more than 20 members of the National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW) — Greater Minneapolis Section attended a portrayal of Fanny Brin, played by Maren Hinderlie (second from right), at the Minnesota History Center in St. Paul. Brin was a former NCJW president in the 1930s who devoted her life to four main causes: democracy, world peace, Jewish heritage and women's rights. She also was part of the U.S. delegation to the first United Nations Peace Conference, which was held in San Francisco in 1945.
